The Big Event

The final Big Event 2nd Chance drawing is on, April 6, 2018. What is the Big Event?

The Big Event is an invitation only celebration of the Vermont Lottery's 40th Anniversary. Tell customers if they are invited to the Big Event they can look forward to, giveaways, games, entertainment, and a chance to win prizes of cash and merchandise totaling \$500,000! The Big Event celebration is taking place at the Champlain Valley Exposition Center in Essex Junction, Vermont, on June 1, 2018. Doors open at 4:00 PM EDT and the Big Event starts at 6:00 PM EDT.

Big Event FAQs

Will instant tickets be sold at the Big Event?

Yes, instant tickets will be sold during the event, including validation.

Will food be provided?

Yes, a concession stand will be open for invitees to purchase food at their own leisure.

Will there be handicap accessible seating?

Yes, handicap parking and seating will be available.

Can plus ones win prizes?

Yes, plus ones have a chance to win door prizes.

How can you continue to increase sales and keep lottery players interested?

- Remind customers the more 40th Anniversary instant tickets they submit into 2nd Chance, they increase their chance of winning an invitation to the Big Event.
- Continue to display the promotional materials given to you by your sales representatives.
- Think of creative ways to increase sales of the 40th Anniversary instant ticket. Perhaps hang up a countdown calendar near the registers as the last drawing gets closer.
- Tell customers about the fantastic prizes they have a chance of winning if they are invited to the Big Event (see below).


Brian Mclaughlin - Vermont Lottery's new Director of Security
